Licking Memorial Urgent Care

Patients with minor injuries and illnesses may visit Urgent Care, when their primary care physician is not available.

- Colds, flu and coughing – minor fever
- Sore throat
- Ear infections
- Minor allergies
- Minor fractures or sprains
- Nausea (without persistent vomiting)
- Diarrhea
- Minor burns
- Minor cuts, even those requiring stitches
- Minor eye injuries
- Minor animal bites or insect stings
- Pink eye
- Urinary tract infections
- Skin rashes
- Physicals

Emergency Care (1320 West Main Street, Newark, Ohio)

Patients who have life-threatening illnesses or injuries should report directly to the Hospital's Emergency Department to receive the intensive care they require.

- Severe chest pain
- Respiratory distress
- Head injuries
- Stroke-like symptoms (facial droop or one-sided weakness)
- Seizures
- Poisoning or drug overdoses
- Heavy bleeding
- Multiple injury/bone fractures (with open or noted deformity)
- Fever in newborn baby
- Severe abdominal pain associated with fever, persistent vomiting or rectal bleeding
- Electrical shock
- Snake or spider bites
- Unconsciousness
- Disorientation
- Pregnancy-related problems
- Allergic reactions with respiratory distress
- Vomiting blood or persistent vomiting
- Suicidal or homicidal feelings
