A Message from the President ...

This Annual Report illustrates the remarkable work that is being done by our LMHS family on a daily basis to improve the health of the community. We have an outstanding team consisting of more than 1,700 employees, a highly qualified medical staff, solid leadership from the LMH and LMHS Board, a dedicated senior management team, and hundreds of volunteers, all supporting our efforts. I truly appreciate the knowledge, skills and dedication that each member of the LMHS team adds to the well-choreographed care that the Health Systems provides.

Licking Memorial Health Systems (LMHS) and Licking Memorial Hospital (LMH) received many prestigious commendations over the past year from organizations that closely evaluate the healthcare industry. The awards recognized a range of accomplishments, from overall staff performance to specific programs.

In 2013, LMH was named to the 100 Top Hospitals® list by Truven Health Analytics for the 11th time, and recently received notice of being named on the 2014 list. Every LMHS employee, volunteer, physician and Board Member contributed in some way to 100 Top Hospitals' assessment that included 10 key areas: mortality, inpatient complications, patient safety, average patient stay, expenses, profitability, patient satisfaction, adherence to clinical standards of care, and post-discharge mortality and readmission rates for heart attack, heart failure and pneumonia. No community hospital in the nation has received the award more times than LMH.

Patient safety is also dependent upon each LMHS team member – ranging from the volunteer greeter at the Hospital's main entrance who assists patients requiring a wheelchair, to the surgeon who uses integrated technology to perform delicate surgery that was not possible just a few years ago. LMH's emphasis on patient safety resulted in three national safety-related awards in 2013 – The Leapfrog Group's "A" rating for patient safety, Healthgrade's Patient Safety Excellence Award and Consumer Report's high rating for Surgery Safety. LMH's Consumer Reports' score was the highest of any hospital in Ohio, and tied for third place in the nation.

These awards are an encouraging recognition of the efforts that every LMHS team member makes to provide each patient with compassionate and professional care. (A comprehensive list of awards appears on pages 23 and 24.) However, our true reward comes from the successes that take place every day – stopping a heart attack that is in progress, helping a newborn enter the world, or receiving a grateful smile from a patient on the last day of chemotherapy treatments. Many of our patients are eager to share their stories, and some are featured on pages 3 and 4.

It is important to recognize that the LMHS would not be able to accomplish all that we have without the support of the community members who entrust us with their care every day. We are blessed to have your confidence, and look forward to continue caring for you and your families in the future.

Licking Memorial Hospital - Tamarack

Licking Memorial Health Systems (LMHS) expanded its services this year following the December 2012 purchase of the former Medical Center of Newark (MCN) at the intersection of West Main Street and Tamarack Road. The building, which opened as an LMHS branded facility on January 7, was renamed Licking Memorial Hospital (LMH) – Tamarack, and created space for convenient surgeries and outpatient procedures. During the transition, LMHS was able to offer positions to 65-70 former MCN employees, and former MCN physicians also were invited to apply for LMH Active Medical Staff privileges.

Initially, LMH – Tamarack offered select outpatient services, including the LMH Wound Clinic, Outpatient Laboratory, and select Pre-Admission Testing, but was soon licensed by the Ohio Department of Health as a surgical facility. Eye surgeries have been performed frequently at LMH – Tamarack this year, and plans to expand surgical offerings at the facility include podiatric, urologic and minor orthopedic procedures. Throughout 2013, LMHS has made a variety of improvements to the building in order to ensure high quality medical care that is consistent with the Hospital's standards. The new LMH – Tamarack facility is a result of LMHS' continual assessment of gaps in community medical needs, and contributes greatly to the Health Systems' mission of improving the health of the health of the community.

LMH Wound Clinic

Among the first services to be offered at the new location was the Wound Clinic, which relocated from the Hospital to the second floor of the LMH – Tamarack building in 2013. The Clinic treats outpatients who require care for chronic or complicated wounds, and is staffed by physicians and registered nurses who are specially trained and certified in wound care. During a patient's first visit, the wound is measured and photographed in order to begin a record of the healing process, and the physician and patient work together to create a customized healing plan. The new location of the Wound Clinic within LMH – Tamarack offers additional space for wound care services as well as convenient access for patients.

LMH Pain Clinic

In September, the Pain Clinic at Licking Memorial Hospital also relocated to the second floor of the LMH – Tamarack building, as part of LMHS' expansion in outpatient services. The Pain Clinic is a specialty clinic dedicated to the effective treatment and control of chronic pain. LMH Pain Clinic patients receive personalized care from physicians who are experienced in utilizing advanced

pain management procedures in order to effectively treat many types of chronic pain. The Pain Clinic's new location at LMH – Tamarack offers efficient and convenient care for its patients.

Eye Surgery

When the LMH – Tamarack location opened its new surgical area in July, ophthalmologists Elliot Davidoff, M.D., Mark S. Law, M.D., and James E. Silone, D.O., of the Center for Sight in Newark, were the first to perform outpatient procedures. Collectively, the physicians typically perform over 30 cataract surgeries per week, making it the most commonly performed surgery at LMH. Setting it apart from many metropolitan hospitals, LMH – Tamarack offers a 'no needle, no stitch, no patch' cataract surgery, allowing patients to recover from cataract surgery more quickly. Drs. Davidoff, Law and Silone also perform other ophthalmic surgeries at LMH – Tamarack, including eye muscle surgery, tear duct probes, glaucoma surgery and pediatric surgeries related to eye trauma.

Laboratory Services

To improve patients' ease of access to laboratory services, LMH – Tamarack offers timely, accurate, state-of-the-art testing from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, augmenting the services already offered at the Hospital. The staff is dedicated to providing a high level of technical expertise and excellent customer service, as well as definitive test results.



Patient Experience

Licking Memorial Health Systems (LMHS) maintains its mission of improving the health of the community by providing excellent patient care at each of our convenient locations with the latest technologies and medical procedures, as well as promoting good health through many of our community initiatives, such as the Active•Fit Program. Many community members have shared their appreciation for having access to outstanding healthcare resources available locally.



“It was frightening to be told that my baby needed to be placed in the special care nursery. I began to realize just how fragile a premature baby can be. However, the nurses and doctors were phenomenal. They answered all our questions and reassured us that Maeley was doing very well. “I noticed a slight discomfort in my chest. It was nothing major, but it was enough that I mentioned it to my wife, Angie. I thought I could not be having a heart attack because I was only 35. I had intended to have Angie drive me to LMH, but I had a feeling that we should call the squad. The squad was there in seven minutes, and began giving me care immediately. The emergency medical technicians (EMTs) transmitted my vital signs and EKG results directly to the Emergency Department at LMH, which allowed me to bypass the normal registration process. I know that arriving by the squad gave me access to more expedient care than I would have had otherwise. I am appreciative of the prompt, reassuring care that I received from the EMTs, and am grateful to the skilled, attentive medical team at LMH whose professional training and intuitive attention to detail saved my life.”

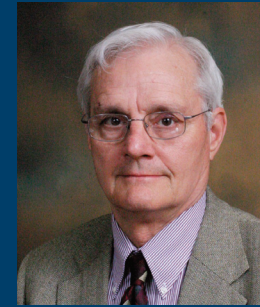

Changes, Enhancements and Technology

Licking Memorial Health Systems (LMHS) is dedicated to keeping abreast of medical advances and improving the healthcare experience for patients and their families. In many instances, the changes are subtle and take place without the public's awareness. Changes and improvements at LMHS over the past year include:

Licking Memorial Hospital – Tamarack

Licking Memorial Hospital – Tamarack opened on January 7, and provides convenient access to high quality care. The LMH Wound Clinic and LMH Pain Clinic each relocated to the LMH – Tamarack building, creating additional space, efficiency and convenience for outpatient services. Laboratory services and state-of-the-art eye surgeries were also made available at this location, soon to be joined by podiatric, urologic and minor orthopedic surgeries.

LMH's Heart Failure Performance Leads Ohio Hospitals

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) released a report in September stating that LMH's percentage of heart failure patients who were re-admitted within 30 days of being released from the Hospital was lower than the national average, and the lowest of all Ohio hospitals, regardless of size. A low hospital re-admission rate is considered significant because it indicates excellent comprehensive care and reflects the use of a full spectrum of technologically advanced services by a highly competent and passionate staff.

Licking Memorial Women's Health Adds New Office

Licking Memorial Women's Health opened a third location this year to address the healthcare needs of the community. In addition to physician offices on Messimer Drive in Newark and at the Pataskala Health Campus, Licking Memorial Women's Health now offers another convenient location at 270 Goosepond Road, off of 21st street, in Newark.

Licking Memorial Women's Health – Urodynamics

According to the National Association for Continence, one in four women over the age of 18 experience involuntary bladder leakage during physical activity, or when coughing, laughing or sneezing. Previously, local residents had to travel to Columbus for procedures to treat urinary incontinence, but Licking Memorial Women's Health now offers the convenience of urodynamic testing in Licking County. Through a contractual agreement, Bladder Health Network conducts state-of-the-art testing on site, and Dr. Ngozi Ibe reviews and discusses the results and treatment options with patients.

LMH Named on 2013 Health Care's Most Wired Award List

LMH was recently recognized as one of the Most Wired Hospitals of 2013. Conducted in cooperation with McKesson Corp., AT&T, the College of Healthcare Information Management Executives, and the American Hospital Association (AHA), the Most Wired Award is given to hospitals that have made great strides in establishing and creating robust clinical information systems aimed at improving patient care. LMH has focused heavily on implementing advanced technology in recent years, including mobile radiology and biomedical equipment, barcode medication administration, handheld devices to capture patient vital signs and lab data, Vocera nurse call and paging system, and wireless infusion pumps. LMH also utilizes monitoring equipment that sends data directly into the Hospital's Electronic Medical Records (EMR).





LMHS Opens New Rheumatology Practice

LMHS recently added a new specialty physician practice to a growing range of available healthcare services within the community. Rheumatology is the study and treatment of conditions that affect muscles, bones, and joints, including rheumatoid arthritis, lupus, fibromyalgia, and osteoporosis, among others. Licking Memorial Rheumatology is now part of Licking Memorial Health Professionals, a group of more than 100 healthcare physicians in 23 areas of specialty who are dedicated to improving the health of the community.

Sports Medicine Specialty Care Comes to Licking County

Sports medicine is a medical specialty dedicated to the prevention and treatment of injuries and illnesses that result from participating in athletic activities. Although there are several outstanding orthopedic surgeons on the LMH Active Medical Staff, it was evident that the Licking County community would benefit from a sports medicine specialist. In order to address that need, Orthopedic Surgeon and Sports Medicine Specialist Michael A. Vaccariello, M.D., was welcomed as a member of the LMH Active Medical Staff. Dr. Vaccariello's expertise includes surgeries of the knee and surgeries of the shoulder. He works closely with local physical therapists and athletic trainers to develop and implement personalized treatment plans, monitor each patient's progress, and return athletes to their sport as quickly and efficiently as possible.

2013 Radiology Initiative

The LMH Radiology Department has undergone a structural renovation and technological update, thanks to the 2013 Radiology Initiative. Patients can expect to benefit from the following changes: A nuclear medicine expansion, including two private injection rooms, three semi-private imaging rooms, and two replacement nuclear medicine gamma cameras, equipped with state-of-the-art single-photon emission computed tomography (SPECT) technology combined with computed tomography (CT) technology or SPECT/CT technology. The Radiology Initiative has also included the replacement of three ultrasound imaging systems with expanded technology at two off-site locations, as well as the upgrade of five ultrasound imaging systems within the Hospital's Radiology and Neurovascular Lab. Additional provisions include the replacement of the current stereotactic breast biopsy systems with the digital spot mammography, the replacement of a Mammotome® dual vacuum-assisted tissue biopsy device and tissue specimen management device, three fully digital mobile fluoroscopic C-arms for surgery, and three fully digital mobile X-ray systems.

Community Events: Dedications, Receptions and Open Houses

Licking Memorial Health Systems (LMHS) welcomes and encourages community input in order to ensure that our technology and services anticipate patients' constantly changing needs. Residents and employees were invited to many events during 2013 to celebrate areas of growth and to become familiar with the healthcare environment. Dedications, receptions and open houses in 2013 included:



Corporate Breakfasts – The Licking Memorial Hospital (LMH) Development Council hosted four Corporate Breakfasts in 2013. The events served to acquaint local business and community leaders with new services, technology and health trends within the Hospital, as well as within the healthcare industry as a whole. This year's topics included a summary of the Health Systems' accomplishments and activities in 2012, an introduction to the surgical management of thyroid nodules at LMH, a discussion of acute inpatient therapy and a presentation encouraging heart attack awareness.

New Physician Receptions – To familiarize patients with new physicians, the Licking Memorial Development Council hosted a New Physician Reception in September. At the event, members of the public had an opportunity to meet 12 physicians who had recently joined the LMH Active Medical Staff.

Pastoral Care Event – In April 2013, LMH hosted its annual dinner for members of Licking County's clergy. The event featured a presentation on crisis management, including a discussion on distinguishing between a crisis and stress, the coping mechanisms of each, and how quality relationships are able to aid in the handling of a crisis. In addition to providing religious and spiritual services to patients and their families and visitors, as well as staff members, the LMH Pastoral Care Department also serves as the liaison between the Hospital and local clergy.

Cancer Survivors' Picnic – In recognition of National Cancer Survivors' Day, LMH hosted its third-annual Cancer Survivors' Picnic on June 9. LMH patients, guests and employees gathered on the Hospital's front lawn to celebrate and support cancer survivors, and to honor lost loved ones.

Donor Appreciation Reception – LMHS thanked contributors during the annual Donor Appreciation Reception in September. The event is an opportunity for donors to be recognized for their generous gifts and receive information on current and future projects at LMHS. At the 2013 reception, the latest piece in the LMHS Main Street Collection, a replica of the Howard E. LeFevre Electronic Wall, was unveiled for donors who have reached the \$7,500 level of giving. All donations are used to purchase new medical equipment and technology, and enhance the healthcare facilities at LMH.



Lifetime Achievement Reception – Each fall, the LMH Development Council hosts the Lifetime Achievement Reception in recognition of individuals who have made an extraordinary difference in the community. Eschol Curl, Jr. received the 2013 Lifetime Achievement Award for his devotion to numerous non-profit organizations that advance education and wellness issues for local residents. The Lifetime Achievement Award was created in 1989 and is the highest award that LMHS confers each year. The Development Council also presented the Look Up Dental Clinic with the ninth annual Building a Healthier Community Award in recognition of its efforts to address the unmet need for urgent/emergent dental care for uninsured, low-income adults in Licking County.

Active•Fit Award Receptions – LMHS hosted three special receptions in the past year to honor Active•Fit prize-winners from each of the three periods. In 2013, more than 1,200 Licking County children, ages 6 to 12, registered for the youth wellness program, and those who completed their goals each period were entered into a special drawing. The 20 winners for each period, as well as their families, gathered to receive their prizes, enjoy healthy refreshments, and celebrate their achievements in February, June and October.

LMH Support Groups – In 2013, community members were invited to join one of three newly offered support groups at LMH. The free meetings were offered at various times throughout each month and included A New You: Weight Loss Support Group, a Breast Cancer Support Group, and the First Impressions Breastfeeding Mothers Support Group. The support groups provide education and discussion led by LMH employees who have expertise in the subject matter.

TWIGS and Volunteer Recognition Dinners – The annual TWIGS Recognition Dinner was held on May 15. The TWIGS organization raised nearly \$124,000 in donations throughout 2012, and LMH was proud to honor their outstanding dedication to the Hospital. The annual Volunteer Recognition Dinner was held on April 25 to pay tribute and show gratitude to more than 150 individuals who regularly devote their time to LMH. During the event, Harry Harper was the recipient of the 2013 Donald Day Volunteer of the Year Award in recognition of more than 2,920 hours of service since 2007.

Development Council Mission

To increase charitable giving to the Hospital, and to enhance and promote meaningful community relations resulting in the Hospital's ability to meet community needs and better serve its publics.

Fundraising

Licking Memorial Health Systems (LMHS) relies, in part, on charitable donations to proactively incorporate technological advances and meet growing community needs. The Development Department at Licking Memorial Hospital (LMH) works diligently to ensure that the Hospital has the funds available for continuous improvements and to offset the expense of charity care. Contributions to LMHS are used to purchase equipment and to fund programs, capital expenses, and facility improvements. The contributions are not used for salaries or general operating expenses.

Community Cornerstone Club – The Community Cornerstone Club is comprised of community members who contribute \$100 or more to Licking Memorial Health Foundation (LMHF). As of 2013, the Cornerstone Club has 150 members who have raised \$23,575 toward the 2013 Radiology Initiative. Donors receive a Main Street Collection recognition piece at each \$500 milestone of giving. The 2013 addition to the Main Street Collection recognizes donors who have reached the \$7,500 level of giving. The new piece is a likeness of the Howard E. LeFevre Electronic Wall that is located in the lobby of the surgery entrance of the John and Mary Alford Pavilion.

The Caduceus Society – Physicians have their own opportunities to lend financial support through The Caduceus Society, which is a prestigious giving level for physicians who pledge a gift of \$10,000 or more over a period of 10 years. New members in 2013 included two anonymous donors, Jill Nicholson, M.D., Sarah & KW Tim Park, M.D., William A. Stallworth, M.D., and Dr. and Mrs. Edward J. Starinchak. The Caduceus Society has a total of 70 members.

Golden Corporate Honor Roll – The Golden Corporate Honor Roll distinguishes companies which have made a total commitment of \$10,000 or more to LMH. Participation in this program signifies the company's alliance with the Hospital to ensure the continuation of excellent healthcare services. The Golden Corporate Honor Roll gained five members in 2013, including The Energy Cooperative, Kaiser Aluminum, Fifth Third Foundation, Greenfield/Lewis Investment Counsel and Packaging Corporation of America.





The John Alford Fellowship – The John Alford Fellowship gained six members in 2013, and now has a total of 34 members. The John Alford Fellowship was created to memorialize the extraordinary commitment of LMH’s long-time supporter, John W. Alford. New members in 2013 included: Glenn and Alice Ann Abel, Mark and Leslee Arthur, Diane M. LeMay, M.D., Stuart and Marcia Parsons, Lorei Frame Reinhard, and Jeff and Nancy Smith.

Platinum Circle – The Platinum Circle is reserved for LMHF’s business and corporate donors who have contributed \$25,000 to \$49,999. These gifts enable LMH to purchase new equipment and provide additional services to meet the healthcare needs of the citizens of Licking County. Gutridge Plumbing, Inc. joined the Platinum Circle in 2013.

Benefactor Level – Benefactors are special friends of LMHS, both individuals and businesses, who support the LMHS mission to improve the health of the community by donating between \$50,000 and \$100,000. LMHF has nine Benefactor Level contributors. James J. and Christine L. McGee advanced to the Benefactor Level of giving in 2013 after completing their previous John Alford Fellowship and William Schaffner Society commitments. Twentieth Century Club was also recognized as a Benefactor.

Founder Level – Founder Level members are altruistic individuals who have made outstanding contributions to LMHF by providing gifts of \$100,000 or more. LMHF is fortunate to have 15 Founder Level memberships. The Licking County Foundation became a Founder Level donor in 2013.

Licking Memorial Golf Gala – The annual Licking Memorial Golf Gala took place at the Granville Golf Course on June 24, with John Hinderer serving as honorary chair. The team from Kool 101.7/WNKO, whose members

included Richard Day, Todd Harrold, Tom Swank, and Mark Walters, took first-place in the tournament. MedBen, Newark Advocate Media, Park National Bank, Stedman Flooring, Inc., and Turner Construction were Ace Sponsors with a contribution of \$5,000 each. Eagle sponsors (\$2,500) included CS Construction, Gutridge Plumbing, Inc., The Jerry McClain Companies, Limbach Company, LLC, Summit Custom Cabinets, Surgical Interventions, LLC, and US Foodservice. A total of 132 golfers played in the 2013 Golf Gala, which raised \$73,255 to benefit the 2013 Radiology Initiative, an increase of more than \$4,500 from the previous year.

PRIDE – LMHS employees have a special opportunity to support the Health Systems with charitable contributions through payroll deductions to PRIDE (Providing Resources in Dedicated Employees). As of December 2013, PRIDE had 630 members. Since 1987, PRIDE contributions have raised more than \$2 million.

Paving Our Future Commemorative Bricks – LMH’s Development Council offers a distinctive way to recognize family members, friends or organizations with commemorative bricks. The bricks are available in two sizes for personalization and placement in one of LMH’s exterior walkways. In 2013, nine commemorative bricks were purchased, totaling \$2,500.

Honorary and Memorial Giving Program – Many community members appreciate the opportunity to pay tribute to a loved one, commemorate a special event or celebrate a recovery through monetary contributions that benefit LMH. In 2013, LMHF received six honorary and 59 memorial donations, totaling \$6,045. In addition, 30 contributors made Doctors’ Day donations to honor their physicians, for a total of \$3,430.

Employment

Licking Memorial Health Systems (LMHS) has provided employment opportunities for Licking County residents for more than 100 years. Not only is LMHS the largest employer in Licking County, but it also has established a reputation as the leading healthcare provider in the community. This distinction is largely due to the dedication of the Health Systems' 1,700 employees who serve diligently to provide quality care for patients and visitors.

LMHS has high standards for its employees and believes in recognizing and rewarding their accomplishments through various celebrations, including monthly Dining with the Stars recognition breakfasts and luncheons, bimonthly employee birthday events and various annual recognition dinners.

Hospital & Healthcare Week – The annual celebration featured a health fair to provide employees with information to enhance their own health. LMHS also hosted an outdoor employee cookout and announced special employee recognition awards throughout the week, including the Clarissa Ann Howard Award for Clinical Excellence, MVP Awards and the Manager of the Year Awards.

Employee Recognition Dinner – During the Employee Recognition Dinner at Longaberger Golf Club in May, 220 LMHS employees were recognized for their dedication in 5-year incremental years of service, including three employees celebrating 40 years.

National Doctors' Day – Physicians were treated to an honorary breakfast, free massages and a gourmet lunch in appreciation for their dedication to the community.

Medical Staff Recognition Dinner – The recipient of the LMH Physician of the Year Award, Shakil Karim, D.O., was announced at the dinner, which is held annually to honor physicians who provide dedicated care to the community.

Retiree Dinner and Luncheon – In 2013, retired LMHS employees were invited to two Retiree Luncheons at the Newark Metropolitan Hotel, in addition to the 17th Annual Retiree Dinner in the LMH Café. More than 100 LMHS retirees gathered at the Dinner on July 17 to reconnect with former coworkers and to learn about recent developments within the Health Systems.

37th Annual Holiday Party – Employees were invited to a complimentary meal of delicious holiday favorites prepared by our own food service staff, and were entertained by the Ultrasounds. The menu included three carving stations of slow-baked ham with pineapple and cherries, beef tenderloin with horseradish sauce, and roasted turkey with gravy. Employees also enjoyed citrus pepper salmon, chicken and noodles, and beef and noodles, as well as traditional side dishes, shrimp cocktail, seasonal chilled salads and an extensive selection of delicious desserts.





In January 2013, employees celebrated 115 years of providing quality health care to the community with an annual interdepartmental competition to collect new blankets and outerwear. The gifts were donated to The Center for New Beginnings and the Salvation Army of Licking County to help individuals and families in need. Additionally, LMHS employees participated in the Licking County United Way Campaign, and were the top contributors to the Food Pantry Network of Licking County's Operation Feed Campaign.

LMHS offers a comprehensive benefits package that includes tuition assistance, free uniforms, and free access to various wellness center sites, as well as excellent health, dental, and vision insurance. In 2013, LMHS implemented several new programs to better serve its employees.

New LMHS Scholarship Announced - Licking Memorial Health Systems was pleased to announce the establishment of a scholarship at COTC/OSU-N as part of the Newark Campus Development Fund. The scholarship is awarded with preference given first to LMHS employees, then to children or spouses of LMHS employees. In the event that there are no eligible candidates from either of those groups, the scholarship is offered to students on either campus who are pursuing degrees in health related fields. One to three scholarships will be awarded each year based on merit, and the amount will vary annually. Employees are invited to apply via the Employee Portal or by visiting the Human Resources offices on Tamarack Road and at the Hospital.



Employee Concierge Service - Licking Memorial Health Systems was excited to announce the addition of a new service for LMHS employees starting in December. The Volunteer Department expanded to include a concierge service, offering various benefits including dry cleaning pickup and delivery, package and mail services, and gift wrapping. The concierge service became available just in time for the holidays, offering wrapping for up to three gifts at no charge. The shop, which is located on the LMH Ground Floor next to the Maintenance Shop, is open 6:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
